Clothing and Winter Attire

Bundle up! With the cold weather upon us, we would like to remind families and students of the importance of dressing appropriately for the weather including hats, mittens, and snowpants.

As the weather changes we ask that all students pack a change of clothes in the event that their clothing gets wet or dirty/muddy while going outside during recess or lunch.





School Drop-Off and Pick-Up

A reminder to follow street signage for both 'no stopping' and 'no parking' around the school. For safety reasons, we ask that you do not park too close to the foot of the driveway. This is to ensure the buses can make the turn when they leave the school.

Please do not turn around in the neighbours' driveways when dropping off. This is especially important as snow banks develop along the sidewalks, making it harder to see people walking and crossing streets. We ask that you do not park in the staff parking lot

for drop-off and pick-up. Thank you in advance for your understanding and cooperation.

Plans for Inclement Weather

Did you know? HRCE takes great care when making the decision to alter the regular operations of schools and school buses in the event of severe or inclement weather.

It is HRCE's goal to communicate any changes to the regular operations of schools and/or buses as close to 6:00 a.m. as possible. A 6:00 a.m. announcement could be:

- All schools are delayed in opening by two hours and bus pickups are delayed by two hours; or
- All schools are open, but some or all busses are not operating for the day; or
- Some schools (either individually or by family) are closed for the day; or
- All schools are closed for the day.

If weather deteriorates, or is forecasted to worsen throughout the morning, an 11:00 a.m. announcement could be:

- Bussed students will be picked up two hours earlier than their regular dismissal time; and
- Walking students will be dismissed at their regularly scheduled lunch hour.
